

The Circumcision and Name of Jesus January 1, 2023

JESUS BLESSES US WITH HIS NAME AND SAVES US WITH HIS BLOOD

Our newborn God keeps the Law for us and brings Abraham's promises to their fulfillment when He is circumcised. It is there that the Name above all names is "bestowed on Him" (Phil. 2:9), "the Name given by the angel before he was conceived in the womb": Jesus, "the Lord saves" (Luke 2:21). He sheds the first drops of His precious blood in accordance with this Name and in anticipation of His cross, "for He will save His people from their sins" (Matt. 1:21). The law's captivity gives way to the freedom of faith in Christ Jesus, who cuts a new covenant in His blood to be received by faith, whether male or female, Jew or Greek (Gal. 3:23–28). His Name is given to us in Holy Baptism, and we are made sons of God and "heirs according to promise," true offspring of Abraham by faith (Gal. 3:29). Eight days after the celebration of our Lord's birth, a new "Year of our Lord" is begun in Jesus' holy Name and with His benediction. Jesus is the Lord, and by this Name we are blessed (Num. 6:22–27).

Communing at this Altar

The Lord's Supper is celebrated and offered here every Lord's day! *Guests wishing to join our confession and receive this Holy Sacrament now, and in the future, are asked to meet with the pastor before communing.

Because we consider communing at this altar a public declaration of fellowship in what our church believes, teaches, and confesses, we welcome to commune those who:

- ✤ are baptized into the Name of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit (Mt 28:19);
- ✤ confess Jesus Christ as their personal Savior from sin;
- discern the Lord's Body and Blood as truly present, together with the bread and wine (1 Cor 11:29), as taught by the Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod in the Small Catechism;
- ♥ examine themselves and repent, as instructed in the Scriptures (1 Cor 11:28);

believe the words of Jesus, "*Given and shed for you for the forgiveness of sins*" (Mt 26:28); If this is *not* your confession, or you're seeking a church home and wish to learn more about Trinity, our Pastor will gladly meet with you after the service. In the meantime, we welcome you forward for a blessing during the distribution. Simply come forward and, when kneeling, *cross your arms over your chest*, indicating that you'd like to receive a blessing.

As you commune, select either the individual cup or the common chalice. Communicants who cannot easily come to the altar will be communed in the pew. *Please notify an usher or the Pastor beforehand if you need such assistance*.

To help prepare yourself to receive the Lord's Body and Blood you may read "<u>Christian</u> <u>Questions with Their Answers</u>" found on pages 329 and 330 of the hymnal.


Galatians 3:23-29
