**The Lord's Prayer, LSB 324**

**The First Petition**

*Hallowed be Thy name.*

**What does this mean?**

*God's name is certainly holy in itself, but we pray in this petition that it may be kept holy  
among us also.*

**How is God's name kept holy?**

*God's name is kept holy when the Word of God is taught in its truth and purity, and we,  
as the children of God, also lead holy lives according to it. Help us to do this, dear Father  
in heaven! But anyone who teaches or lives contrary to God's Word profanes the name of  
God among us. Protect us from this, heavenly Father!*

**The Second Petition**

*Thy kingdom come.*

**What does this mean?**

*The kingdom of God certainly comes by itself without our prayer,  
but we pray in this petition that it may come to us also.*

**How does God's kingdom come?**

*God's kingdom comes when our heavenly Father gives us His Holy Spirit, so that by  
His grace we believe His holy Word and lead godly lives here in time and there in  
eternity.*

Prayer of the Week...

*O God, in the glorious transfiguration of Your beloved Son You confirmed the  
mysteries of the faith by the testimony of Moses and Elijah. In the voice that came  
from the bright cloud You wonderfully foreshowed our adoption by grace.  
Mercifully make us co-heirs with the King in His glory and bring us to the fullness  
of our inheritance in heaven; through the same Jesus Christ, our Lord, who lives  
and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever.*
