Paideia, a term that is more on our minds these days as we consider how to properly bring up the next generation, is the origin of our term 'pedagogy'. It means training, chastising, and even educating. Our times have seen a vast divergence from what the reformers understood their task in pedagogy to be. Surprising to us though, even they were making something of a leap in pedagogy from what had come before. Things have moved well beyond their imaginings and have fallen short of some of their hopes. How did we get here? Over three sessions, we will discuss pedagogy in the classical and ancient world, what humanistic education in the time of the renaissance meant, and finally how we have arrived at the pedagogy of the



present in our public education. Together, we can reflect on the historic vocation of the Lutheran Church in America, and specifically the Missouri Synod and our call to obedience in the present.
